- 04.38.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-An unofficial project that just happens to cost seven point four billion dollars a year to operate.
- 04.45.20 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-The President and the Joint...
- O4.46.18 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Chiefs thought if they granted the Senator the apropriate clearances -- let him in on the existence of the SGC -- he'd recognize its importance to national security and authorize the expenditure.

	has asked me to hear you out. So here I am.
09.21.18	O'NEILL-Well, as long as you've got an open mind.
09.28.03	GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel

- 09.29.20 O'NEILL-For crying out loud, Samuels, what'd you tell this man?
- 09.32.28 SAMUELS-The truth.
- 09.34.18 KINSEY-Colonel Samuels was entirely non-partisan.
- 09.37.04 O'NEILL-Okay. Now <u>that's</u> impossible. He's been against this program from day one.
- 09.41.28 SAMUELS-If anything, I voiced my awe and amazement at what the Stargate is.
- 09.47.04 SAMUELS (OS CONT)-A technological marvel.
- 09.49.08 CARTER-It is so much more than that, Senator. The

- 09.56.28 CARTER (OS CONT)-We have learned more about astrophysics in these...
- 09.59.01 CARTER (CONT)-few months than in the last fifty years!
- 10.02.15 DANIEL (OS)-It also gives us insights into human cultures that...
- 10.04.18 DANIEL (CONT)-are thousands of years old.

- 10.06.28 KINSEY-Dr. Jackson... I'm sure as a scholar of ancient mythology, you are familiar with the story of Pandora.
- DANIEL-From Greek mythology, of course. (beat) The first woman ever created by Zeus, who, according to legend, gave her a box and warned her never to...
- 10.22.07 DANIEL (OS CONT)-open it.
- 10.22.26 KINSEY (overlapping)-But she did. Out of curiosity.

 Despite the warning of her god, who was also her father... she did. And from it sprung all the plagues, pestilence and evil that exist now in this world.
- 10.36.05 DANIEL-And keeping in mind that we are talking about a "myth"... She closed it in time to keep "Hope" inside.
- 10.42.02 KINSEY-Then should we not close your gate for the same reason... to keep "Hope" inside?
- 10.47.22 O'NEILL (OS)-Senator...

- 11.50.04 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-But if you want to talk about maintaining...
- 11.51.08 O'NEILL (CONT)-the first line of defense against what I believe is...
- 11.54.23 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-the greatest enemy humanity has ever faced...
- 11.57.25 KINSEY-Hyperbole...
- O'NEILL-See for yourself! General, I suggest we dial up old P4A 771, I believe it was. See how long the good Senator lasts in that world.

- 12.59.20 TEAL'C-They speak the truth.
- 13.01.03 KINSEY-I'm not entirely convinced of that, either.
- 13.03.11 O'NEILL (OS)-General,...

- 13.03.16 O'NEILL (CONT)-what the hell are we doing here? This man has made up his mind already.
- 13.06.14 KINSEY-Sit down, Colonel.
- 13.08.04 KINSEY (OS CONT)-When I've made up my mind,...
- 13.09.08 KINSEY (CONT)-you will know it! (beat) I will ask you once more. Sit down. Please.
- 13.23.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel...
- 13.32.02 . KINSEY-I gave the President my word that I would give you a fair hearing, and I intend to do that.

- 14.57.10 O'NEILL (CONT)-"U". It's pronounced...
- 14.59.24 CARTER-Goa'uld.
- 15.01.18 KINSEY (OS)-I assume --
- 15.02.00 KINSEY (CONT)-since shortly after arriving, you were captured and imprisoned -- that you would characterize this world as an enemy stronghold.

- 15.10.08 O'NEILL-I would.
- 15.14.07 SAMUELS-I read from the personal report of Colonel Jack
 O'Neill, dated the 23rd of February. (reads)

 "Skaara was chosen. I tried to stop them from
 taking him away, but was struck by an Alien staff
 weapon. In that moment, Apophis gave the order..."
- 15.31.03 APOPHIS-Kill the rest.
- 16.11.28 O'NEILL-I can save...
- 16.12.22 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-these people!
- 16.16.14 O'NEILL (CONT)-Help me! (beat) Help me.
- 16.23.11 TEAL'C-Many have said that. (beat) But you are the first I believe...
- 16.30.06 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-could do it!
- 16.53.18 O'NEILL-Get out of the way!
- 17.08.16 O'NEILL-C'mon, let's move!
- 17.09.19 CARTER-Come on, come on!
- 17.12.21 CARTER (OS CONT)-Move! Go! Come on! Come on!
- 17.15.06 CARTER (CONT)-Go! There you go! Go! Go, go! Come on!

- 17.37.22 KINSEY (OS)-So, even with your team unarmed, at the enemy's mercy, in the palm of their hand, as it were,...
- 17.45.19 KINSEY (CONT)-one of their own was able to set you free.
- 17.49.06 CARTER-I-it wasn't that simple, Senator.
- 17.52.16 KINSEY-Read on, please.
- 17.54.08 SAMUELS (OS)-(reads) "We met heavy resistance..."
- 17.55.15 SAMUELS (CONT)-"...on our return to the Stargate, and became pinned down by enemy aircraft."
- 18.09.27 O'NEILL-Take cover!
- 18.50.08 CARTER-Colonel, we're sitting ducks here!
- 19.10.05 KINSEY-It seems to me that Major Kawalsky made light work

 of what you referred to in your report as a "Death

 Glider"...
- 19.17.14 O'NEILL-They were taken by surprise. I wouldn't expect it to be as easy next time.
- 19.23.03 KINSEY-Why not?

- 19.24.15 DANIEL (OS)-Well, for one thing, they weren't used to fighting humans...
- 19.26.17 DANIEL (CONT)-with our level of technology. Now they know what we have.
- 19.29.28 CARTER (OS)-I don't think you understand...
- 19.30.27 CARTER (CONT)-how much more powerful their weapons are.
- 19.34.00 KINSEY-Yet you managed to get away with minimal casualties. Hardly the greatest threat humanity has ever faced. (beat) What's happening?
- 19.50.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-It's just SG-2 returning on schedule,
 Senator.
- 19.53.26 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-There's nothing to worry about.
- 19.59.13 KINSEY-Oh, I disagree, General. I think it is something to worry about.
- 20.14.04 O'NEILL (VO)-Mr. Kinsey...
- 20.14.21 O'NEILL (CONT)-seems to be under the impression that the Goa'uld are not a military threat.
- 20.19.18 KINSEY-You seem to have defeated them handily at every turn.
- 20.23.22 O'NEILL (OS)-Did you read...
